Here are a few tips to help your student adjust back to the routines and expectations of school.</li> <li>Visit the your child's school campus as often as possible over the summer</li> <li>Begin back to school routines now</li> <li>Keep consistent meal and snack times</li> <li>Implement bedtime routines and rituals on the same schedule as when school is in session</li> <li>Schedule a time for your child to see their school friends prior to the start of school</li> <li>Talk it up! Let your children know how excited you are for them to go to school and learn</li> <li>If your child expresses anxiety, reassure them there are lots of adults to support them at school</li> <li>Practice school procedures and routines - packing and unpacking backpacks, combination locks, morning routines, how to record homework and assignments</li> <li>With your child, set up their homework and reading space at home</li> <li>Establish calendars with deadlines for college applications, after school activities, special events</li> </ul>
